#### New Electoral Roll .....

The electoral roll is your parish's register of electors who can vote you can vote at the Annual Parochial Church Meeting (APCM) and stand for election to the PCC. Names can be added or removed at any time, however it is formally reviewed and revised annually with minor amendments such as a change of address. To ensure that its contents remain substantially correct, every sixth year a new electoral roll is created from scratch and every person who wishes to have their name entered on the new roll, whether it is entered on the present roll or not, must apply for enrolment. The process for producing the new electoral roll is governed by the date of the Annual Parochial Church Meeting, and in the year the roll is renewed the timetable starts much earlier with a 2-month window for people to submit new forms.

**CLOSING THIS WEEK ....** The electoral roll for **High Easter** is now open and forms are available from Jane Boden, electoral roll officer for High Easter parish. The roll closes on 19<sup>th</sup> April. APCM date is Sunday 4<sup>th</sup> May.

The electoral roll for Good Easter is now open and forms are available from Beverley Garrod, electoral roll officer for Good Easter parish. The roll closes on 26<sup>th</sup> April. APCM date is Sunday 11<sup>th</sup> May.

The electoral roll for Margaret Roding is now open and forms are available from the parish administrator. The roll closes on 3<sup>rd</sup> May. APCM date is 18<sup>th</sup> May.

The electoral roll for South Rodings is now open and forms are available locally or from the parish administrator. The roll closes on 10<sup>th</sup> May. APCM date is 25<sup>th</sup> May.

If the parish is not listed above, the electoral roll has closed ahead of the APCM.

# **NEW** Benefice Mission Event 2025 .....

An invitation open to all across the deanery to join us in 2025 as we explore faith through a creative lens.

We start with a trip to Ely Cathedral on Saturday 14<sup>th</sup> June 2025 to see Threads through the Bible by Textile Artist Jacqui Parkinson. It is an astonishing, inspiring exhibition of textile art. With spectacular designs, brilliant colours and extraordinary stitching, you're taken through a journey from the first pages to the last pages of the Bible.

It is probably the largest ever textile project by a single person! There are 44 huge spectacular panels, each almost 3m high and up to 4m wide. If all the panels were laid out side by side, they'd stretch more than 80 metres!
